Parks and Recreation Discipline Plan

Facility Rules are posted throughout the Community and Aquatic Centers. All patrons are expected to abide by these rules. Tiers 1-4 identify types of behaviors with the consequences if non-compliance of the rules occurs.

To ensure the safety of our young patrons, parents are responsible for the behavior and supervision of their children.

Bullying/Harassment Policy Defined

 The community and aquatic center environment shall be free from intimidation for all patrons. Threatening the safety or rights of another person, violent or disorderly behavior, threats of violence or use of abusive language, possession of weapons, blocking entrances or interfering with people entering/exiting the building are not acceptable.

Disruptive Behavior Defined

- No one may interfere with another person's right to use the facility free of disruption or with the staff's performance of their duties.
 - Examples of disruptive behavior include use of obscene language, running, throwing objects, resting feet on furnishings or equipment, or any activity resulting in the disruption of facility use. The P&R Staff are empowered to identify disruptive behavior. Refusal to comply with the reasonable request of the staff members will be considered disruptive behavior.
